

CROATIAN SOCCER TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL

- a) Seek written permission to participate in the Tournament from your respective Soccer Federation.
- b) Register your Club's participation **by date stipulated by the Croatian Soccer Federation**
- c) Provide Host Club / Croatian Soccer Federation with Team Sheets and Registration numbers.
- d) Supply Host Club with Team photo and team line-up by the stipulated date.
- e) Supply Club / Team Emblem by the stipulated date.
- f) Both Home and Away strips to be available during the Tournament.
- g) Collect Team and / or Miss Croatia Australia Package on the Thursday night of the Tournament.

RESPONSIBILITIES TO THE CROATIAN SOCCER FEDERATION

- a) Full members pay yearly membership of \$200 by July 31st.
- b) Non affiliated members (participating and 'pub' teams) to pay yearly membership fee of \$300 by July 31st for the first three years, thereafter a \$200 membership fee (Full Membership) applies. All members must serve a three (3) year probation period before they are entitled to full membership.
- c) Each team to arrange it's own player insurance or sign waivers to compete for both male and female teams. These details will be posted separately in coming weeks.
Please note: If your Club has existing insurance from your governing body, which provides adequate cover to participate in the tournament, please forward a copy of your Insurance Policy.
- d) Provide updated Contact Details to the Assistant Secretary of the Croatian Soccer Federation.
- e) Attend the Annual General Meeting (AGM) on the Friday of the Tournament. President and Secretary to attend.

TEAMS – MALES & FEMALES

- a) All players, coaching staff and Miss Croatia Australia entrants to attend the Opening Ceremony of Tournament.
- b) Players (male or female) **cannot play for more than one team** during the duration of the Tournament.
- c) Yellow and Red Cards will be counted and any penalties will be implemented. FIFA playing rules will be followed.
- d) No interchange allowed, however up to six (6) substitutions allowed per game.
- e) A Disciplinary Committee (Two Savez members and one Host Club member) will be formed. The Disciplinary Committee will resolve any incidents involving violent play, unsportsmanlike behaviour or any other behaviour deemed to require disciplinary action by any club or it's supporters and individuals.
- f) Host Club to provide a maximum of 20 players passes per team (one food / drink voucher per day). Player passes will be distributed according to the number of players and coaching staff on team sheet.

MISS CROATIA AUSTRALIA

- a) Clubs to hold Miss Croatia Quest prior to September.
- b) Register your Miss Croatia Australia Entrant participation by date stipulated by Host Club.
- c) Supply Miss Croatia Australia Entrant details and photo to Host Club by date stipulated.
- d) We strongly encourage teams to attend the Miss Croatia Australia Gala Evening. A discount on entry tickets (maximum 20 per team to the Miss Croatia Ball for players and officials participating in the tournament will apply).
- e) Pay accommodation costs for Miss Croatia Australia Entrant – Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings. All Miss Croatia Australia entrants will stay together in the one location (Host Club to organise hotel location). Please note: All other costs incurred whilst a guest at the hotel will be the sole responsibility of each entrant e.g. Mini bar, room service, phone calls etc.
- f) Provide sash for the Miss Croatia Australia Entrant.
- g) All Miss Croatia Australia events / functions during the duration of the Tournament will be compulsory.
- h) Miss Croatia Australia Entrants may play with their respective club, as long as **it does not conflict with any Miss Croatia Australia commitments.**
- i) Miss Croatia Entrants to attend a meeting with the Savez to discuss rules etc after the Opening Ceremony of the Tournament.
- j) Host Club to provide Entrants with food / drink passes for the duration of the Tournament (one meal and drink per day), free entry into games, gala night and discos.

HOSTING OF CROATIAN SOCCER TOURNAMENT

- a) Hosting of a Croatian Soccer Tournament Form to be filled in and returned to the Secretary of the Croatian Soccer Federation by date stipulated by Croatian Soccer Federation.

- b) Formal Presentation (5–10 min) will be required at the AGM for Board of Directors and all members present.
- c) Attend meeting with the Board of Directors on the Saturday of the Tournament.

MISCELLANEOUS

- a) Follow Rules & Regulations provided by the Host Club.
